1. Parents are reminded to sign the children's developmental assessment report of February in the handbook.
2. School Health Guidelines :
In order to ensure the health of our campus, staff members are required to complete RAT and wear masks at school every school day. We **encourage** our students to wear masks at school, since they are young and their body resistance is weak, also, because of the peak season of influenza, in order to reduce the risk of cross-infection and to protect the health of children. Thanks for your cooperation.
-If the child has the symptoms of fever, flu, cough, runny nose, etc., please do not come to school and see a doctor immediately. The child needs to rest for 2 more days after the fever subsides.
-If the child got COVID-19, please do not go to school until recovered with a negative test result.
-Please put clean masks in students' school bag (3 masks for half-day classes/ 5 days for whole-day classes).
3. The annual joint school parent-child activity “Activities for parent-child to creating close time together” is on March 4(Sat.). All participants please wear winter sportswear and colorfast sneakers and gather at school at 8:45 a.m. punctually.
4. March Birthday Party & Music Talent Show is on March 17. Please encourage children to sing nursery rhymes, songs that taught at school or playing musical instruments in the show, and sign up with class teacher. Please bring the assisted musical instruments or CD to class teacher on that day. Casual wear is welcomed for kids. Please bring along their own belongings with their rucksacks and homework bag while school bag is not needed. School hour remains normal.
5. Our school social worker Ms Kong Shuk Ling from Hong Kong Family Welfare Society will organize a “Blessed Family Day” parent-child day trip for K1 on Apr. 6 (Thu.). Available for 10 families, the

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registration will be on first come first serve basis until fully occupied. Please refer to the notice for more details.

6. In order to promote good health care habits to children, we (N1-K3) is going to join the "Love Teeth with Your Kids Programme" from the Oral Health Education Division (Department of Health). Please fill in the "Children's Pledges and Parent's Pledges" (P.2). Please conduct "Teeth Brushing Record" for 12-week period and fill in "Oral Care Animation: from 6th March to 26th May. Kindly return the "Student Oral Care Record Book" to class teachers every Monday. Teachers will record their performance on ranking table accordingly. Please refer the attachment for more details.
7. Based on the guideline of Social Welfare Department, healthy meal is provided to children in order to caring about children's health. Also, vegetable oil is used. Please inform class teacher, if your child has food allergies or other special conditions. Attached with the menu of Week 1 to 3 of March 2023.
